The Center for Public Leadership takes great pleasure in announcing the recipients of the prestigious Reynolds Foundation Fellowships in Social Entrepreneurship for 2007–2008. Established by a generous gift from the Catherine B. Reynolds Foundation, the fellowship seeks to accelerate the preparation of a new generation of public leaders who can bring the insights of entrepreneurship and management to bear on social problems.

The program enables 25 students per year, on average, to pursue master's degree programs at Harvard's Graduate School of Education, School of Public Health, or John F. Kennedy School of Government. The Fellows also participate in a cocurricular program designed by the Center for Public Leadership that focuses on leadership development and professional skill building.

The 2007–2008 Reynolds Foundation Fellows bring a wealth of experience in public service and social entrepreneurship to the Harvard community, including work for organizations such as the Peace Corps, VISTA, Teach for America, Food for the Hungry, and the U.N. Development Programme, and businesses such as Microsoft, McKinsey, and Morgan Stanley. Eleven of the 2007–2008 Fellows have founded their own enterprises. Two have been Fulbright Scholars. One has been named one of the Ten Outstanding Persons of the World for Social Enterprise, and another has been included among ABC News' People of the Year.
